Ours is a self-financed college. It has been established to fulfil the demand for academic excellence and professional expertise in Howrah and adjoining areas.

COLLEGE CAMPUS

FULLY AC CLASSROOM

COLLEGE LIBRARY

ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

PAYMENT OF TUITION FEES

The Semester fees which includes tuition fee & session charges will be accepted online through Student Dash Board or at the fee counter at college by Demand draft/Pay order or debit/credit card. No cash will be accepted.

Semester fee must be paid within one month from the commencement of every semester, otherwise a fine Rs. 100 will be charged per month. Names of defaulters for more than three months may be struck off from the college register.

Transfer Certificate Fee/ Admission cancellation Fee: Rs.500.00

For obtaining Transfer Certificate/getting admission cancelled/refund of Caution Deposit etc. a student will have to clear all outstanding amount up to the date of application.

Session Charges per annum:

Session Fees includes Development fees, Library fees, Laboratories Fees, Sports Fees etc.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

To take admission in our college students should directly visit our website only, (www.shreeagrasaincollege.net) for online application and follow further proceedings as stated therein for final admission.

Admission in the college is subject to the rules and regulations prescribed by the University of Calcutta and by the management of the college.

- Online Application Forms and Prospectus will be available from the College Website: www.shreeagrasaincollege.net
- Student must fill up all required details as per their testimonials.
- Form submission to be done through online.
- **Date of admission will be declared as per University notification.**
- Final admission will be confirmed only after original document verification.

Online Submission of admission forms does not guarantee admission.

All admissions are provisional. Any admission done (inadvertently) contrary to the Rules and Regulations laid down in the prospectus and/or University of Calcutta will be treated as cancelled. Admission to the college and permission to take up particular combination of subjects are subject to the rules and regulations prescribed by the University of Calcutta and at the discretion of the college authority.

Documents necessary at the time of final admission:

- Mark sheet of the last qualifying examination.
- * Admit Card and Mark Sheet of Class 10 and class 12 or equivalent (for proof of age).
- * Two Stamp size colour photographs.
- Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or its equivalent from the All India Boards / Councils (i.e. C.B.S.E, I.S.C. and National Institute of Open Schooling) need not require to submit the Migration Certificate for getting Registration under Calcutta University.

Students coming from other University/ Board must submit the Migration as well as Pass certificates in original for getting registration under Calcutta University.

RULES & GENERAL CONDUCT OF DISCIPLINE

- 1. As for teaching and learning process, a very peaceful, calm, and untroubled atmosphere is required, maintenance of silence in the college campus is absolutely necessary.
- 2. The college provides Identity Cards to all regular students. Students are required to bring the Identity Cards whenever they are in the college campus and to produce the same to the appropriate authority on demand. They are forbidden to bring outsiders without prior permission from the college authority. Duplicate Identity Card will be issued at the payment of Rs. 20/-, if it is lost.
- 3. An act of discourtesy to female students will be deemed as serious offence and will be punished accordingly.
- 4. Smoking and chewing pan or pan-masala are strictly forbidden.
- 5. Students are requested to co-operate with the college authorities in keeping the college and its compound clean. AC, lights and fans are to be switched off when not needed.
- 6. Bicycles and Two-wheelers should be kept in proper place.
- 7. Students are requested to use the different facilities available to them in just and proper manner. Improper use/wilful destruction of any article/furniture /accessories by a student will invite penal action.
- 8. Playing music on Transistors, Tape-recorders, Mobile phones or any other similar gadgets with or without earphones is strictly prohibited in the college premises. Action will be taken against violators. Use of cell phones is strictly prohibited in all areas of the main building. The college will not be responsible for loss/theft/damage of the same nor will entertain reports of the above. In case of emergency, college land lines may be used by the students with prior permission.
- 9. Plucking of flowers within the College compound is forbidden.
- 10. Violation of rules mentioned above will make a student liable to disciplinary action which in case of serious or repeated offences may include expulsion from the college.
- 11. The College is under close surveillance of CCTV.

A student found in indulging in any unruly activity/ behaviour in the campus will be suspended and / or expelled from the college.

RAGGING

Every student is required to give an undertaking in writing countersigned by the guardian at the time of admission to the effect that he/she will not indulge in act of ragging. Strict action will be taken in accordance with the directives of the Supreme Court in case any student is found to indulge in ragging.
